Maple Lake – Lake Property Owners Association

The Maple Lake, Lake Property Owners Association (ML-LPOA) works yearround to promote the community and be good stewards of the Lake, from its successful Ice Fishing Derby that draws thousands of people to town to its AIS prevention, and walleye stocking plans.

They know that a healthy and clean recreational lake benefits the entire community. On Wednesday, Feb. 26th, the Maple Lake Chamber of Commerce recognized the ML-LPOA for its efforts with the Chamber Business of the Year award.

Chamber President Mike Rowe presented the group with the award Wednesday night at the annual Chamber Social at the Maple Lake American Legion.

The Business of the Year award honors a local business that has excelled in growth and support for the community. The business must be an active chamber member that promotes community events and encourages community involvement.

"Even though ML-LPOA isn't a main street business, they should be recognized for their on-going efforts to keep Maple Lake a viable recreational asset which is an attraction for our businesses," the group's nominator said.

Derby

The Lake Property Owners Association is perhaps best known for its wildly popular Maple Lake Ice Fishing Derby that happens every early February, if the weather is cooperative. This year the event celebrated 50 years. Not only does the contest bring thousands of people into the community to shop local businesses and eat at local restaurants, funds raised stay in the community, and some are donated back to local non-profit groups.

The economic impact of bringing so many people to town on a single day is huge for the city and the businesses in town, said ML-LPOA member Greg Thomes.

Thomes estimated the number of people who attended the event in February neared 9,000 thanks to plenty of ice and pleasant weather, although he suspects the snow did deter some from coming out. In 2019, at the height of its glory, an estimated 12,000 people gathered on Maple Lake.

It takes a lot of volunteers to pull off the event, and many of the Association's 175-plus members donate their time every year. Local non-profits also get in on the act and as a thank you, their organizations are given a donation, Thomes said.

This year the Farside 4H Club, Maple Lake Boy Scouts and Maple Lake Royalty were all involved and benefited from their efforts, Thomes said. The Knight's of Columbus were also able to take advantage of the huge crowds to host a successful gun raffle fundraiser.

The rest of the proceeds from the derby go toward keeping the lake strong and healthy, Thomes said.

Throughout the year, the Lake Association makes other donations as well to organizations like the Irish Anglers fishing team and events like the St. Patrick's Day festival.

Water quality and fishing

Keeping a clean, recreational lake is important to both lake property owners and everyone who uses the lake. Maple Lake has two public water accesses (at Hwy. 55 and Hwy. 37) and a swimming beach.

The ML-LPOA spends nearly \$50,000 annually to combat invasive species like Zebra Mussels, Eurasian Milfoil and the newest concern, Flowering Rush, Thomes said. The Lake Association is also committed to keeping Maple Lake a quality fishing lake.

The Lake Association and Minnesota Department of Natural Resources work together to stock the lake with walleyes every year. The ML-LPOA fronts the bill in odd years and the DNR pays for stocking the lake in even years.

Over the course of 2024, the DNR stocked 3,139 walleyes equaling 524 pounds.

The Lake Association also lobbied and succeeded in lowering the daily panfi sh limit on Maple Lake to improve size and quality, Thomes said. On March 1, 2024, the new limits were enacted. The daily sunfi sh limit was reduced from 20 to 10 and the daily crappie limit from 10 to five.

According to Joe Stewig, MN DNR Fisheries, research has found that reduced bag limits for sunfish and crappies can be an effective tool to maintain or improve size quality.

MLIDWC

The Lake Association also has an active Lake Improvement District, which allows for greater local involvement in lake management activities. Last spring the ML-LPOA contributed \$49,500 to build a weir across Mill Creek to maintain water quality and proper lake levels. Headed up by the MLIDWC it was a project 3 ½ years in the making and it involved numerous organizations including the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources and Stantec engineers.

The Lake Association also hosts a Fourth of July the DNR so walleyes are stocked every year. Boat Parade every summer that encourages people to decorate their boat and get out on the lake for fun and prizes. The boats tour the lake showing off their creativity while a panel of judges determine whose boat is the best decorated.

Strong board

"We have a great, strong board right now with a lot of new faces. The life blood of any organization is new people with new ideas and we're trying to get as many people involved and helping the community as possible. They're excitement and enthusiasm, we hope rubs off on others," Thomes said.

Honored

"We are honored to be part of this community and honored to receive this award. We will try to continue to be good stewards," Thomes said.







Greg Thomes is an old hand at winning awards centered around the Maple Lake St. Patrick's Day celebration.

In 1999 he earned the title of Commodore and in 2014 he was bestowed the honor of Grand Marshal for his service to the community.

Now it's his turn to be the Maple Lake Chamber Member of the Year.

The Chamber made the announcement at its annual Chamber Social, Wednesday Feb. 26 at the Maple Lake American Legion. The Social is a night dedicated to honoring those who happily do their part to promote and support their community through volunteerism. Other awards given were Grand Marshal, the Community Service Award and the Chamber Business of the Year award.

The Chamber Member of the Year goes to the member that attends and participates in chamber meetings, shows leadership and contributes to the community in a commitment of time and

"Greg has been an active member of the chamber over the years and has spent countless hours each year organizing the Maple Lake Ice Fishing Derby that brings hundreds of people to our town," his nominator said.

Thomas agreed that the Derby's economic impact on the community has been huge. Although it doesn't happen every year because of the weather, when it does, it draws thousands of people to town where they spend money at local businesses and then go home and tell others all about it.

Thomas has chaired the derby committee for the Maple Lake, Lake Property Owners Association since 2007 and he's witnessed the impact it has on local bait and sporting goods shops in both Maple Lake and the surrounding communities.

"I think a lot of other people could be recognized for this (award)," he said. "But if in our small way we put Maple Lake on the map, that is wonderful."

Thomes became active with the derby committee through his association with the Maple Lake Jaycees. Back when the contest started in 1975 it was a Jaycee project. Eventually the Maple Lake Public Schools took over and then 17 years ago, the Maple Lake, Lake Property Owners Association (MLPOA) took it on as a fundraiser dedicated to the lake's health and prosperity.

The MLPOA turned it into a derby to deter cheating and allow for the use of fish houses.

Thomes said the Lake Association has always had a lot of dedicated volunteers who work on this event year-round. That, combined with some talented marketing strategists, made the derby what it is today.

Thomes is more than just the

chairman of the derby committee, however.

His involvement started shortly after moving to Maple Lake in 1982. That's when he began serving with the Maple Lake Jaycees. Over the years he served as president at the local level, then the state level then the national level. In 1995, he was named the U.S. Jaycees Foundation president.

Eventually the Jaycees came to an end in Maple Lake, but Thomes continued to do his part to serve the community he lived in. He said volunteering is second nature to him

"I was raised in a family that was very generous and so was Betty (his wife). That giving attitude bestowed on us by our parents is just ingrained," he said.

But there are some wonderful perks to being involved, he admitted

"For example, I was president of the Hasty-Silver Creek Sportsmen's club for many years (2007-2012) and those members became life-long friends, and customers," he said.

Thomes is a third-generation owner/operator of Thomes Insurance Group in Buffalo and has been since 1989.

"I don't do A to get B, but it's a nice result," he said.

Over the years, Thomes has also served as president of the Maple Lake, Lake Property Owners Association; he is a member of

the Experimental Aviation Association Chapter 878 which is based at Maple Lake Municipal Airport; is a member of St. Timothy's parish and is a member of both the Buffalo and Maple Lake chambers of commerce.

Thomes is also a proud member of The McBrady Clan. Although only half Irish on his mother's side, he became part of the clan through marriage and every year can be seen marching among of crowd of kilt-clad Irish men, women and children in the St. Patrick's Day parade.

The tradition started with his father-in-law, Joe McBrady. Joe was the bartender at the Maple Lake Muni and on St. Patrick's Day he served green beer in honor of his heritage. Thomes suspects Joe was the inspiration for what is now the beloved and wildly popular St. Patrick's Day festival.

When the parade started, Joe insisted the McBrady clan have a float in it. The parade also attracted the attention of the Fitzpatrick's of Waverly and for a while there was a good-natured rivalry between the two clans, Thomes said

Today the parade serves as a sort of family reunion for the McBrady's and every year the clan grows bigger. Joe and his wife Mary started with eight children of their own then came spouses and grandchildren, great grandchildren and so on. As the generations accumulated, so has the fun.

Although Thomes doesn't feel deserving of the award, it's clear that others disagree.

"He is there when help is needed," his nominator said.
