



Irish look for win in regular season finale

The Irish football team is officially undefeated at home for the season after last week's 46-16 win over the West Central, Knights.

Friday's (Oct. 10) game was the last home game of the season for the Irish. It was also Tackle Cancer Night and everybody came wearing pink.

Tonight the 5-2 Irish face the Browerville Braves in their final regular season game.

Last week's home game was one the Irish and Irish fans won't soon forget. Irish offense went 592 yards, and Danny Reilley broke the singlegame rushing record. The previous record was 249 yards and Reilley rushed for 303. Reilley also had three touchdowns.

Other Irish highlights include QB Cayden Courtright's 29 passing yards and Ethan Paumen's 18 receiving yards.

The Irish's lopsided win over West Central was the third contest they've won by 24 points or more this season. They've also given fans a lot to be happy about with no losses at home.

Though not quite as successful on the road as they've been at home, the Irish have the better record going into tonight's game against the 3-4 Browerville Tigers. The Tigers struggled through a three-game losing streak before edging Benson 8-6.
